

Room Rates

Inno-Vita has negotiated a discount rate of \$80.00 per night. In order to be guaranteed this price, please ask for the Inno-Vita seminar rate. This rate is good for dates prior as well as after the seminar if you choose to extend. Normal check-in is at 3 PM, check out is noon. Luggage can be stored for Saturday check out.



Parking

The Hotel has underground parking for \$12.00 per night with in and out privileges. For \$15.00 per night they will provide valet services. More economical parking is found on a parking lot to the West side of the building for \$3.00 - \$5.00 per day. They do have overnight parking however this lot does not provide security or in and out privileges.

Transportation from Salt Lake City International Airport(SLC)

Distance: 7.7 miles West to Hotel

Option #1 (Light Rail)

Utah Trax is located outside of the airports terminal 1. Kiosks near each stop dispense tickets for \$2.50 / person. Take the "Green Route" which departs every 15 minutes. *(There are a few stops before it arrives downtown)*. Exit at the stop called "Arena" which is the first stop downtown. The Radisson Hotel is a 1-2 minute walk toward the direction the Trax has just come from.


Option #2 (Airport Shuttle)

Express Shuttle makes regular trips from the airport to downtown. It is more economical than a taxi and has a rate of \$8.00 per person. There are "Express Shuttle" desks located across from the baggage claim, or you can call 800-397-0773 to schedule a pick up.

Option #3 (Taxi)

Several taxi companies await to transport from the airport to the hotel. The average rate of a taxi service downtown is \$24.00 - \$25.00.
